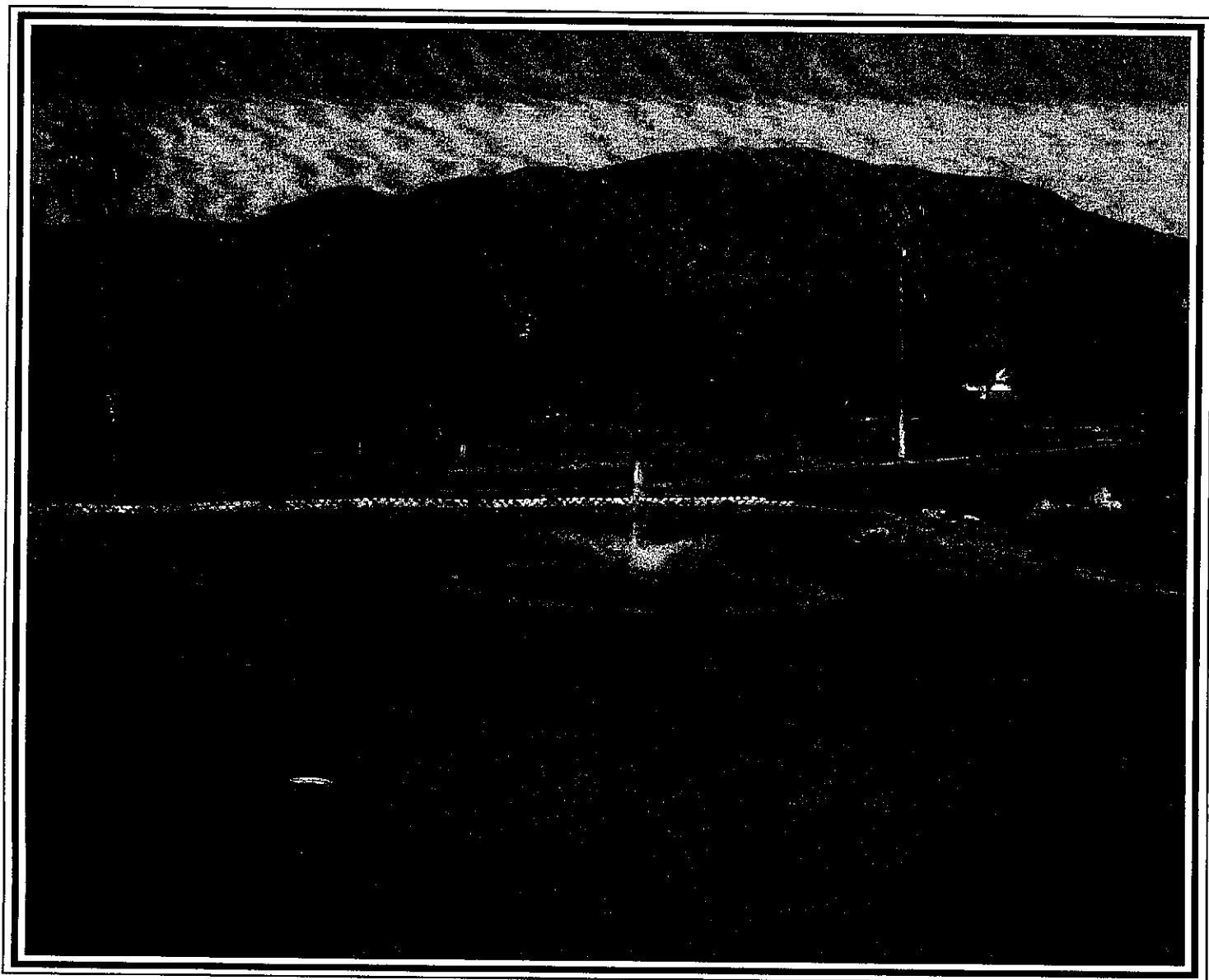

We are in the process of removing the white line and you must play the ball without free a drop option, unless your stance or swing is impeded by an immovable obstruction. This would include concrete, PVC pipe or block wall.
