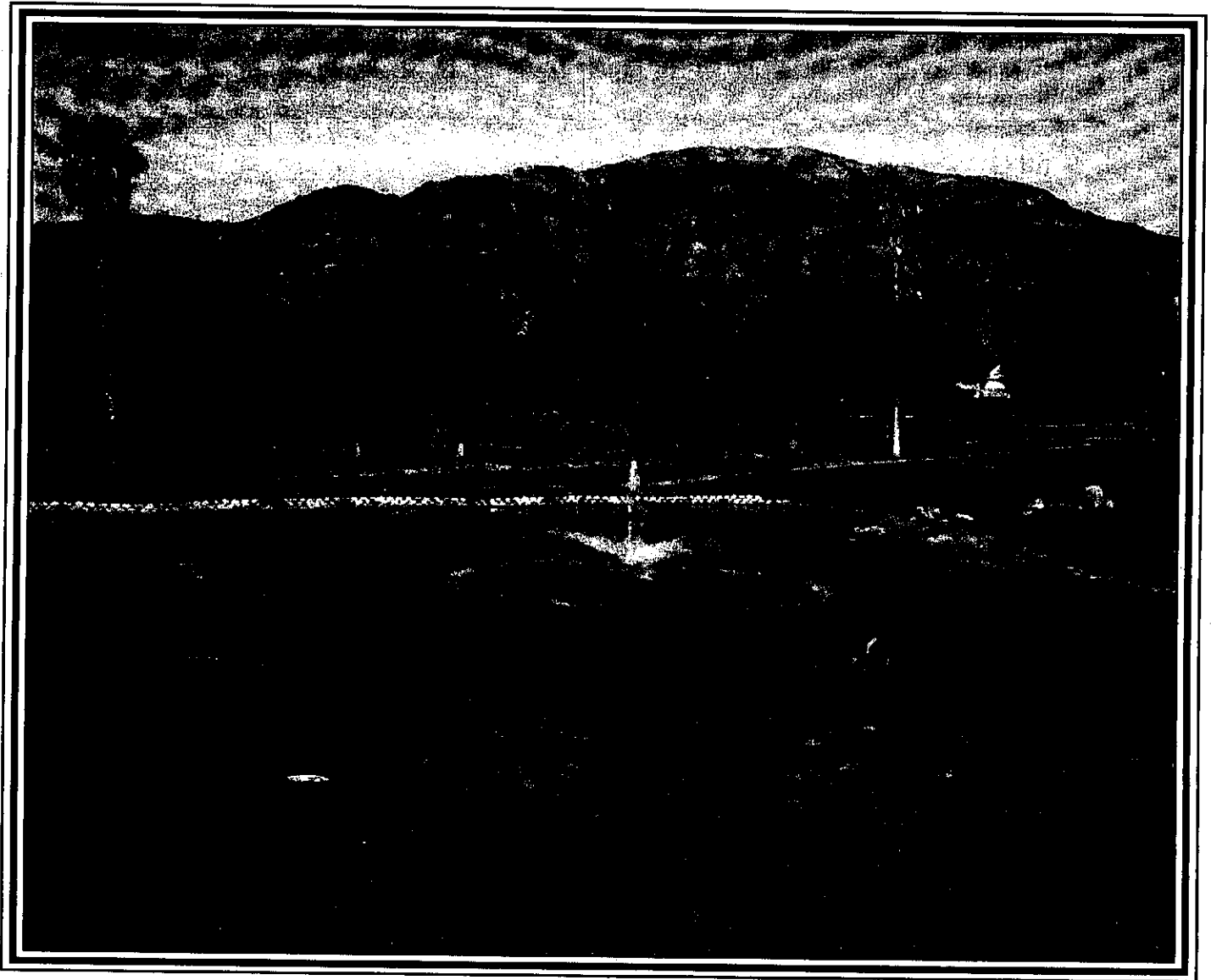

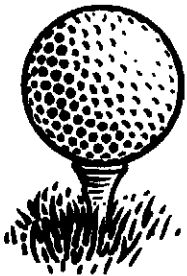

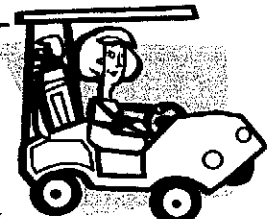
Christmas Tournament
