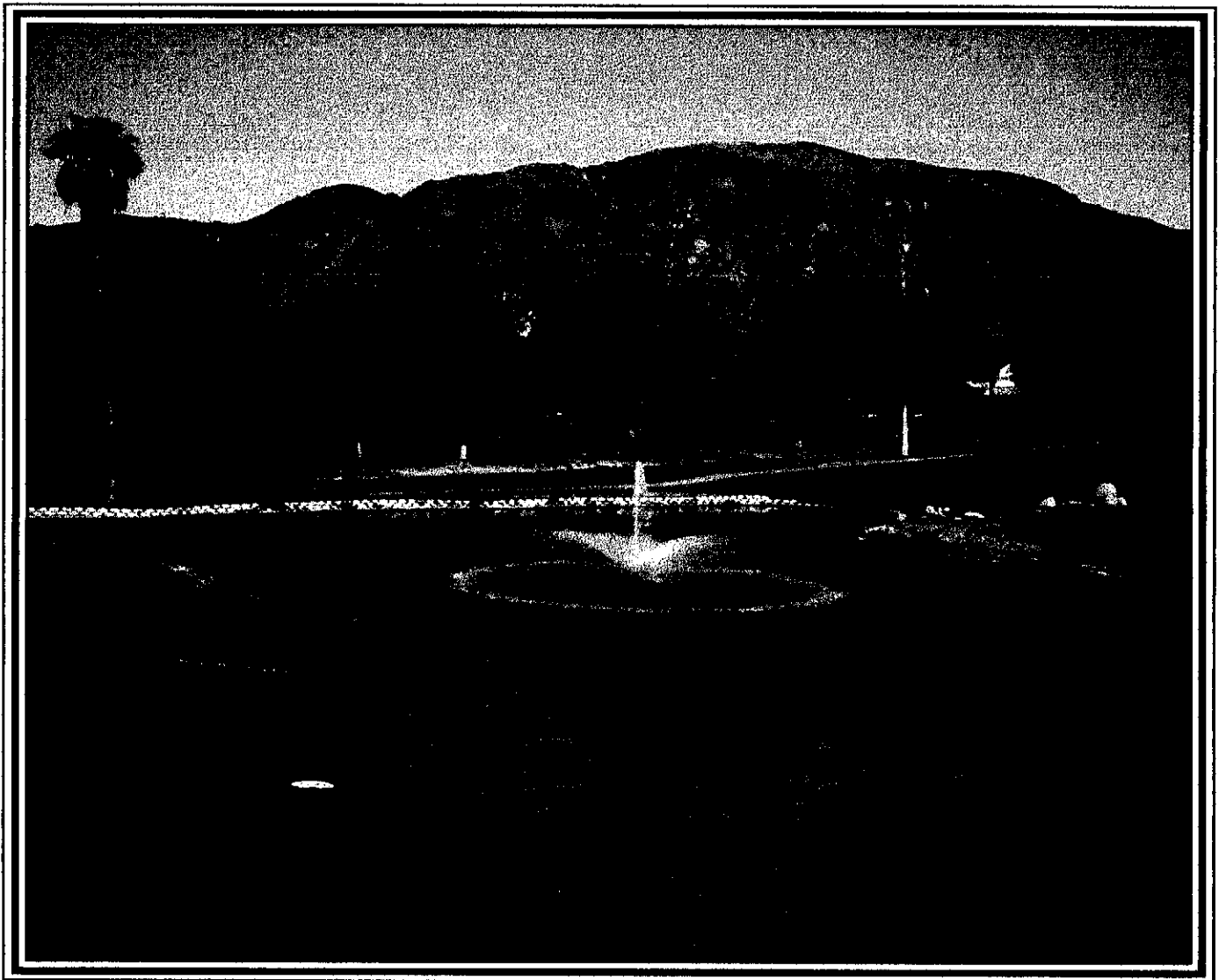

Format: Partners Best Ball – Gross and Net

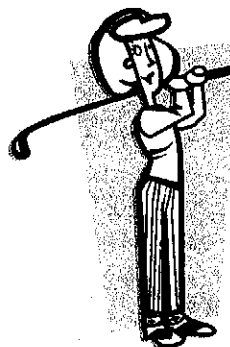
There will be two (2) flights if we get enough players
