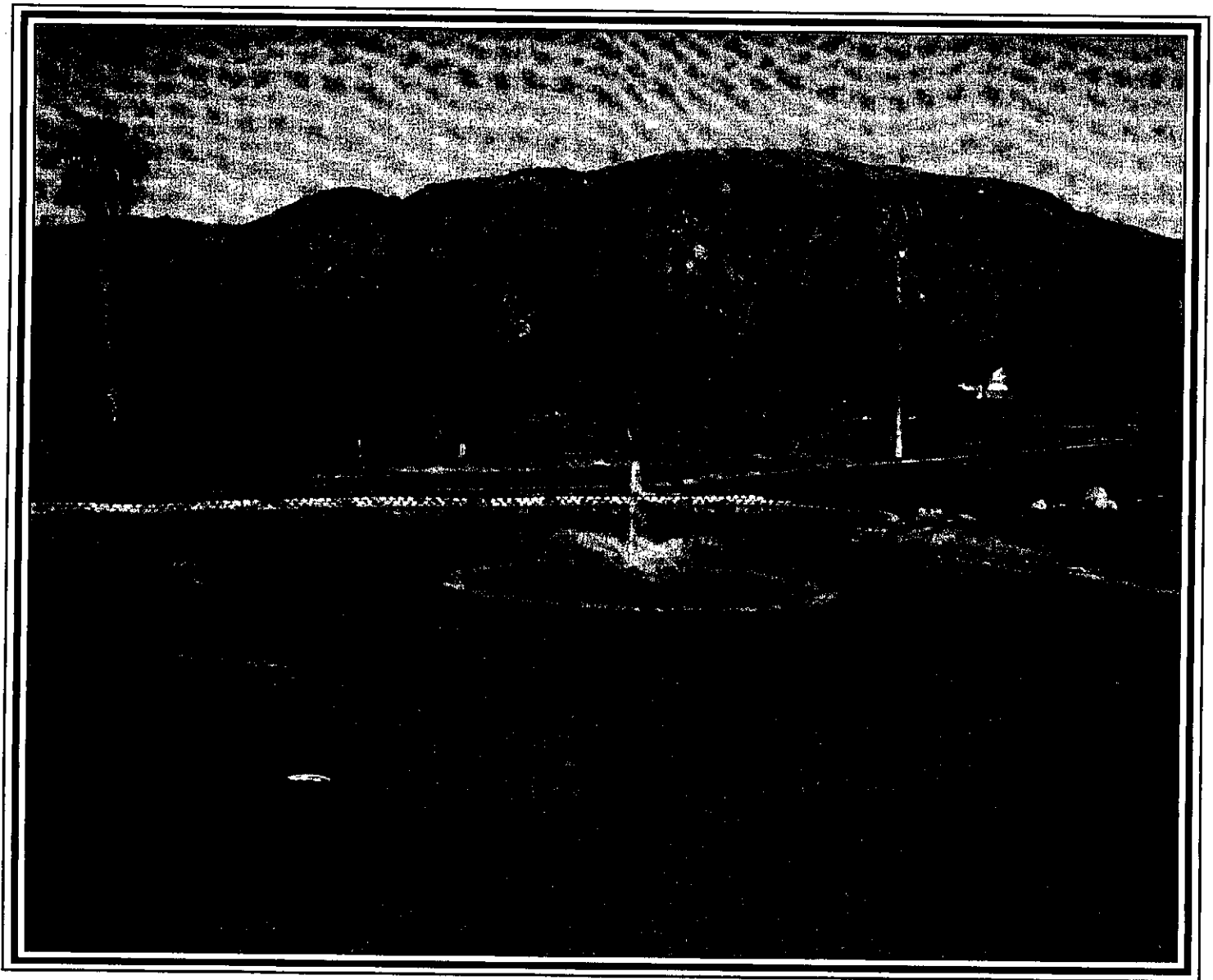

Men's Club Championship

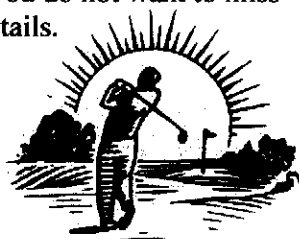

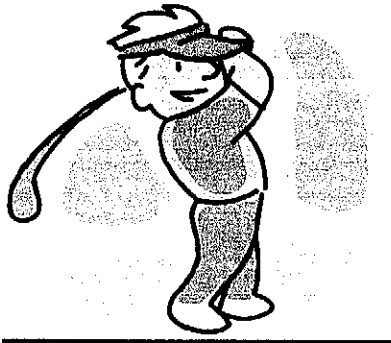

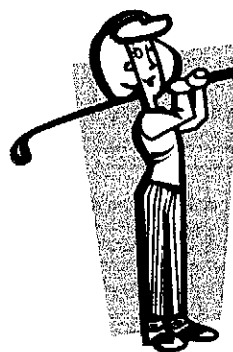
